Nea Uniform Media Policy:

Whereas the Nea Community Believes that:

- 1. Media provides vast resources that have the potential to enhance the educational experience of our learners.
- 2. Media has the ability to powerfully affect learners' mental, social and academic development.
- We must model for our learners how to be savvy, respectful and responsible media interpreters, creators, and communicators.
- 4. Parents should have information about the media our learners consume and create.
- Through informed decision making, our facilitators are able to select age and content appropriate media to enhance their curriculum.
- 6. Ratings systems and resources should be utilized to guide the selection of media resources at Nea. (i.e. Commonsensemedia.org is a valuable resource that provides trustworthy information and tools, as well as an independent forum, so that stakeholders can have information to make informed choices about the media learners consume).
- Media and technology application at Nea embraces diversity in learning styles, accessibility and expected learning outcomes.
